Single Room with en-suite: The weekly fee charged currently ranges from £1,300 to £1,500 per week.

Double room with single occupancy: Subject to availability, the weekly fee charged is currently £1,475 per week.

Double room with joint occupancy: Subject to availability, the weekly fee charged is currently £2,800 per week.

Prices quoted are for guidance only. All prices are subject to an individual care assessment and also the accommodation available at the time of admission.
