

Our prices vary per type of care based on the following criteria

Level of care

Fees may vary for residents based on the amount of individual care needs that are required, ranging from help with personal care to full 1-2-1 care, including feeding, for someone with either challenging dementia or disability.

Fees may also vary according to the size of equipment required, such as hoists or stand aids, which means that a larger room may have to be used.

Level of room amenity

Room prices are effected by location and amenity, ie generally a downstairs room is at a premium compared to an upstairs room, especially if the resident requires hoisting.

If the room is an ensuite room then it is more expensive than a room with just a toilet or washbasin.

Rooms overlooking the gardens may also have a small premium.

Whether rooms are shared by married couples

We have 4 recently refurbished double rooms which are suitable for married couples or siblings. Historically, this works very well for couples where only one has a disability or dementia and the other partner wishes to remain with them as a married couple. We will negotiate a discount on the room to take the sharing element into account.
